This foundation course comprises the first three chapters of NADD Ontario's text *Dual Diagnosis: An introduction to the mental health needs of persons with developmental disabilities*. Learning module topics include a basic introduction to developmental disabilities, recognizing and understanding the mental health needs of persons with developmental disabilities within a biopsychosocial model and strategies for optimizing supports.
